

In honor of mothers and babies, the Agape Offering for May will benefit L.I.F.E. Houston, the only local agency dedicated solely to providing emergency food and supplies for babies.

<u>The AGAPE Communion Offering</u> - The Greek word Agape is used in the New Testament to refer to a kind of love that is not necessarily a feeling but a motivation for action, a sacrificial love that voluntarily gives without expecting anything in return. We are called to Agape love through Christ's example, and we remember that example of sacrifice when we celebrate the Lord's Supper. In order to bring greater awareness of and participation in the Service and Outreach "outside our walls" ministry projects throughout the year, the **Agape Communion Offering** of small, tangible goods will coincide each month with the celebration of Holy Communion. Families are encouraged to participate together in selecting an item to donate and bring to the baskets in the narthex on the <u>first</u> Sunday of each month.
