Happy New Year in Christ's name,

I am so excited for this new year! I am excited to see where God is going to call Pines out into the world, and how the Holy Spirit will move each one of us to do justice, love kindness and walk humbly with our God. We will have an opportunity to respond to the movement of the Holy Spirit by doing justice, loving kindness and walking humbly with God on the weekend of January 20th and 21st as we host our third Feed My Starving Children MobilePack™.

Since our last MobilePack™ was in 2019 you may not know what a Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) MobilePack™ is. Founded in 1987, Feed My Starving Children is a Christian non-profit that provides nutritionally complete meals specifically formulated for malnourished children around the world. Their mission is, "Feeding God's starving children hungry in body and spirit." You see, every year millions of children die from preventable causes such as pneumonia, diarrhea, malaria and undernutrition. Today, hunger still causes nearly half of deaths in children under 5 years old. This is heartbreaking. But we can make a difference!

Their process is simple. Financial contributions given by people just like you fund the meal ingredients. Volunteers hand-pack the meals at MobilePacks™. Meals are donated to FMSC food partners around the world, where kids are fed and lives are saved! Nearly 1.2 million volunteers packed more than 333 million FMSC meals in 2017. More than 90 percent of total donations go directly to feed children.

Through our FMSC MobilePack™ on Friday, January 20th and Saturday, January 21st, here at Pines, our church and community will be responding to the cries of those in need by producing 100,000 nutritious meals for children around the world. You, your family, your co-workers, fellow students, social club, scouting group, team, or whomever, are invited to join 500 volunteers to pack meals for this MobilePack™ event. During a two-hour shift, adults and children 5 years and older will measure and scoop ingredients, seal bags and prepare boxes for shipping. We need you to make this a successful outreach event, so please consider volunteering. To volunteer for our MobilePack™ look for the FMSC link on the Pines web site. If you are unable to attend, we can still use your help in raising some of the funds needed to pay for the meals. Remember \$80 feeds a child for a year, \$365 feeds a family for a year and \$1,800 provides a pallet of food. Scripture reminds us in Psalm 146, "He *upholds* the cause of the oppressed and *gives food* to the hungry." I promise you this will be an amazing time at Pines as we welcome the community and feed the hungry. I hope you'll pray about being part of this amazing day!



STEWARDSHIP NOTES:

1. Pledge and non-pledge income are running behind through November 2022. December is typically an important month for year end contributions. We hope that both amounts will be close to budget as we finish the year.
2. Expenses in most areas are close to or slightly under budget for the year. Property expenses are above budget due to needed repairs.
3. Net income through November 2022 is a \$25,835 deficit. We are hopefully on track for year end contributions in December to bring us into a positive net income position for year end 2022.

Stephen Ministers: The After People

People often ask, “What exactly is a Stephen Minister?” One way to put it is that Stephen Ministers are the *After People*.

Stephen Ministers are there:

- ... *after* the phone call you hoped you’d never get.
- ... *after* the funeral, when everyone has left and the emotions you’ve held at bay come crashing in on you.
- ... *after* the relationship falls apart and the bottom falls out of your life.
- ... *after* the doctor says, “I’m sorry, but there’s nothing more we can do.”
- ... *after* the nursing home director shakes your hand and says, “Welcome to your new home.”
- ... *after* the last child honks the horn, waves, and drives away—and the house suddenly seems empty.
- ... *after* the gavel comes down, the handcuffs go on, and your loved one is led away.
- ... *after* the baby arrives, demanding more of you than you ever dreamed possible.
- ... *after* you find a pink slip with your final paycheck.
- ... *after* your family and friends have heard your story one too many times, but you still need to talk it out.

Stephen Ministers are the After People. They are ready to come alongside you—or your friends, neighbors, coworkers, or relatives—and provide comfort and support for as long *after* as needed.
