

STEWARDSHIP NOTES:

- 1. Pledge Income through June 30, 2021 is running slightly (2%) below forecast. Non-pledge income is slightly more (5%) below forecast. Overall, total income is 2% below forecast through June 30, 2021.
- 2. Expenses have been impacted in June, and also July, by the need to replace the air conditioning unit in the gym. This need was anticipated and the property reserve funds set aside in prior years for this repair will be used to supplement the budget for this cost.
- 3. Net Income as of June 30, 2021 is negative. (-16,689) It is still expected, however, that income will catch up to the budget and we can end the year in a net positive position.

Greetings from the Music Department!

Let's take a look at "Though I May Speak," which is an English folk melody. Hal Hopson wrote this text to the familiar tune in 1972.

The thirteenth chapter of First Corinthians is known as the love chapter in the Bible. It is read at many weddings, telling us just what love is.

"If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing. 1 Corinthians 13:1-3.

Hopson focuses on verse 1 in the first stanza of the song:

"Though I may speak with bravest fire, and have the gift to all inspire, And have not love, my words are vain as sounding brass and hopeless gain."

Verse 2 stresses to give freely with love.

"Though I may give all I possess, and striving so my love profess, But not be given by love within, the profit soon turns strangely thin.

Verse 3 is an actual prayer for the Holy Spirit to come in and control our hearts, our minds, our love.

"Come, Spirit, come, our hearts control; our spirits long to be made whole. Let inward love guide every deed; by this we worship, and are freed.

Let us all be mindful of the words we speak and the love we share.

Who care and answer in extraordinary ways.


