## **Pastor's Page**

### Grace and peace in Christs' name,

I hope you are getting excited about all that God has instore for us in this new year! One of the great things God has been planning for us is our community wide outreach and mission project, Feed My Starving Children, happening February 23<sup>rd</sup>-24th! As many of you know, our FMSC MobilePack<sup>TM</sup> is geared towards welcoming people to Pines while also serving those in need. This year our goal is to package over 100,000 meals for starving children and bring over 500 community volunteers onto our campus.

This year I am excited that we get to celebrate our 4<sup>th</sup> MobilePack<sup>TM</sup>. I have been so thankful for the way our family of faith has responded to this project. Each MobilePack<sup>TM</sup> has been tirelessly supported by you. You've come to believe in the project and the organization. FMSC is a Christian non-profit that provides nutritionally complete meals specifically formulated for malnourished children around the world. Their mission is, "Feeding God's starving children hungry in body and spirit." As we've learned, every year millions of children die from preventable causes such as pneumonia, diarrhea, malaria and undernutrition. Even today, hunger still causes nearly half of deaths in children under 5 years old. This is heartbreaking. But we have, and we can make a difference!

As you may know, their process is simple. Financial contributions given by people just like you fund the meal ingredients. Volunteers hand-pack the meals at MobilePacks<sup>TM</sup>. Meals are donated to FMSC food partners around the world, where kids are fed and lives are saved! Since its inception in 1987 over 4 BILLION starving children have been fed a nutritious meal.

Through our FMSC MobilePack<sup>™</sup> here at Pines, our church and community will be responding to the cries of those in need by producing over 100,000 nutritious meals for children around the world. You, your family, your co-workers, fellow students, social club, scouting group, team, whomever are invited to join 500 volunteers to pack meals for this MobilePack<sup>™</sup> event. Please share with them that during a two-hour shift, adults and children 5 years and older will label bags, measure and scoop ingredients, seal bags and prepare boxes for shipping. We need you to make this a successful outreach event, so please consider volunteering. To volunteer for our MobilePack<sup>TM</sup> look for the FMSC announcement each week in This Week at Pines, or go directly to <u>www.pinespc.org/fmsc</u>. If you are unable to attend, we can still use your help in raising some of the funds needed to pay for the meals. Remember \$106 feeds a child for a year, \$424 feeds a family for a year. To make a donation online please go to <u>www.pinespc.org</u> and click the "Give" button in the upper left had corner, or write a check to the church and note FMSC in the memo line.

Scripture reminds us in Psalm 146, "He *upholds* the cause of the oppressed and *gives food* to the hungry." This will again be an amazing time at Pines as we welcome the community and feed the hungry. I hope you'll pray about being part of this amazing day!


If any children are interested in singing OR ringing the chimes see Laurie (all ages!)

Our Youth have started their Hand to Hand Apartment Outreach ministry! We go the first Sunday of each month and would LOVE to have anyone interested join in! We try to take food or supplies for the residents and always have things to interact with the kids there. Just asking someone their name and hearing how they are doing can be ministry. If you'd like to help make this happen with either a cash or food donation that would be awesome as well. A full grill meal costs about \$250 but it is helpful to have different people willing to give different elements- meat, buns, chips, drinks, etc. This is a work in progress by the Holy Spirit. Looking for adults 18 and older to 'adopt' a student age 4-18 to be a prayer pal. Prayer is the only requirement, though we know it's a bonus to follow one another in life events. 

### **STEWARDSHIP NOTES:**

- At the end of November, \$484,508 pledge income has been received of the \$526,700 pledged for 1. 2023, leaving just slightly over \$42,000 remaining to come in during December to meet our pledge income goal. In addition, we have already received \$105,312 in non-pledge income exceeding our goal of \$101,000.
- 2. Expenses for 2023 are currently underbudget, resulting in a net income of \$45,583 through November.
- 3. December is usually an active month financially both for expenses and income. We anticipate ending the year in a positive net income position, helping to strengthen Pines' financial position and fund new or expanded programs in 2024.
- 4. The Stewardship campaign for 2024 has resulted in pledges of \$560,102 from 80 pledging families, an increase of over \$9,000 in the total pledge amount and 1 additional pledging family. We are immensely grateful for every family that participated in this campaign.




### Wondering how to order flowers for the Sanctuary or Narthex?
