
Can you add one more person to your prayers?

STEWARDSHIP NOTES:

The October, 2023 financial statements can be summarized as follows:

- 1. Pledge income for 10 months continues slightly ahead of budget. Non-pledge income received through October is well ahead (95%) of the year's budget due to unexpected early gifts and continued strong giving.
- 2. Overall expenses were underbudget for ten months. Property expenses are well controlled and under budget. Recent plumbing repairs will increase costs in November. Staff committee expenses are right on target. Missions spending is well below budget and expected to catch up in November when grants are distributed and holiday giving is recorded.
- 3. Total Income was \$568,868; total expenses were \$520,664; leaving a Net Income of \$48,204 for October, continuing our very strong performance this year.
- 4. Mark your calendars! The Trustees and the Stewardship committee will host Pines' representative, Jake Wilson, from the Texas Presbyterian Foundation on Sunday, January 21, 2024, for a lunch following worship. Jake will discuss and answer questions about the importance of leaving a lasting legacy with a planned gift and how to do that.

The Session met for its regular stated meeting on November 27.


Here are some highlights:
