Grace & Peace to you all,



YEAR END TAX PLANNING

Make a bigger impact by donating long-term appreciated securities, including stock, bonds, and mutual funds, directly to Pines. Compared with donating cash, or selling your appreciated securities and contributing the after-tax proceeds, you may be able to automatically increase your gift and your tax deduction.

How does it work?

It's simple and easy. When you donate stock to charity, you'll generally take a tax deduction for the full fair market value. And because you are donating stock, your contribution and tax deduction may instantly increase over 20%¹. Would you prefer to donate bonds or mutual funds? The same benefits apply.

If you would like to take advantage of this tax savings before year-end (or at any time during the year), call Cindy or Alexis in the office, and let them know. They'll send you instructions to give to your stock broker or financial advisor.

Take advantage of a QCD!

If you are at least 70-1/2 years old, and if you have an IRA where you must take Required Minimum Distribution, consider a QCD (qualified charitable distribution), donating all or part of your RMD to Pines (your broker must make the check payable to Pines) – you will reduce your Adjusted Gross Income by the amount of the RMD contribution, and it may also reduce tax on your Social Security income.
